Health Screen II	(Chem 23, Lipid, CBC w/ Diff)	\$40.00
Health Screen III	(Chem 23, Lipid, CBC, T4)	\$45.00
Health Screen IV	(Chem 23, Lipid, CBC, PSA)	\$60.00

WHAT DO THESE LAB TESTS MEAN?

CBCD = complete blood count w/ differential
useful for: detecting disease states or syndromes of white blood cells, red blood cells, or platelet cell lines in peripheral blood

CMP = comprehensive metabolic panel
useful for: assessing the metabolic state, general liver and kidney function as well as the electrolyte balance of a patient

GGT = gamma glutamyl transferase
useful for: diagnosing and monitoring hepatobiliary disease, ascertaining whether observed elevations of alkaline phosphatase are due to skeletal disease or reflect the presence of hepatobiliary disease, and as a screening test for occult alcoholism

LD = lactate dehydrogenase
useful for: investigation of a variety of diseases involving the heart, liver, muscle, kidney, lung and blood, and for monitoring changes in tumor burden after chemotherapy

PSA = prostate-specific antigen
useful for: aiding in the detection of early-stage prostate cancer

LIPID = lipid panel
useful for: the evaluation of cardiovascular risk.

PHOS = phosphorus
useful for: aiding in the diagnosis and management of a variety of disorders including bone, parathyroid and renal disease

URIC = uric acid
useful for: diagnosing and treatment of renal failure and monitoring patients receiving cytotoxic drugs and a variety of other disorders, including gout, leukemia, psoriasis, starvation and other wasting conditions

T4 = thyroxine, total
useful for: aiding in the diagnosis of hypothyroidism and hyperthyroidism; assessing thyroid function in patients with normal thyroxine-binding globulin levels; monitoring patients on hormone replacement therapy
